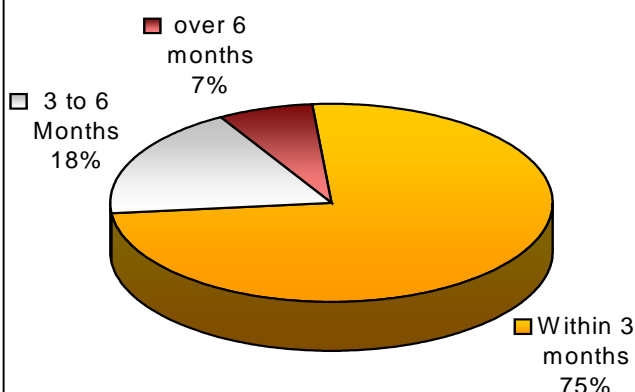

## Performance Report 2003-2004

### Houses added 1st April 2003 to 31st March 2004 Number of Months between Date of Occupation and Issue of Banding Notice



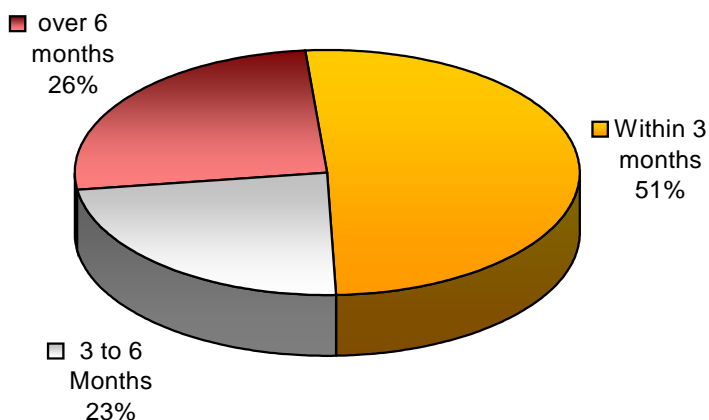
### Council Tax:

During the year 918 houses were added to the Council Tax List. Of these, 617 (75%) were added within 3 months of the date of occupation and 853 (93%) were added within 6 months.

The target set for the year was 87% within 3 months and 93% within 6 months.

The targets set for 2004/2005 are 85% within 3 months and 97% within 6 months.

### Valuation Roll:

During the year 1217 statutory amendments were made to the Valuation Roll. Of these, 617 (51%) were made within 3 months of the effective date of the alteration and 902 (74%) were made within 6 months.

The target set for the year was 55% within 3 months and 79% within 6 months.

The targets set for 2004/2005 are 52% within 3 months and 77% within 6 months.

During the year the number of entries in the Valuation Roll rose from 12,084 to 12,102 and the total rateable value fell from £190.8M to £184.8M.

### General Information:
